Bateman & Bateman was a Birmingham, England-based architectural partnership formed in Birmingham, England in 1887 by [John Jones Bateman](#) (1817-1903) and his son [Charles Edward Bateman](#) (1863-1947) in 1887. Charles Edward Bateman retained the name Bateman & Bateman following the death of his father in 1903.
