

Clegg, Charles Theodore 1861 - 1930



Charles Theodore Clegg was born in Manchester, England on 4 June 1861, the son of the architect [Charles Clegg](#) (1828-1922). He studied at the South Kensington Art School in London before returning to Manchester to join his father's practice in 1882. Not long after [Frederick Knowles](#) (1859-?) joined the practice which became [Clegg Son & Knowles](#). Knowles resigned in 1885 and the practice continued as [Charles Clegg and Son](#).

T. A. Clegg was an elected Fellow of the Manchester Society of Architects. He died in Cheshire on 13 April 1930.
