## Clegg, Charles Theodore 1861 - 1930



Charles Theodore Clegg was born in Manchester, England on 4 June 1861, the son of the architect <u>Charles Clegg</u> (1828-1922). He studied at the South Kensington Art School in London before returning to Manchester to join his father's practice in 1882. Not long after <u>Frederick Knowles</u> (1859-?) joined the practice which became <u>Clegg Son & Knowles</u>. Knowles resigned in 1885 and the practice contined as <u>Charles Clegg and Son</u>.

T. A. Clegg was a elected Fellow of the Manchester Society of Architects. He died in Cheshire on 13 April 1930.
