## **Brown & Burgess 1897 - ?**

Brown & Burgess was an architectural partnership formed by <a href="Frank">Francis [Frank]</a>
<a href="Brown">Brown</a> (1859-1929) and <a href="George Hastings Burgess">George Hastings Burgess</a> (1869-1944) who in 1897 took over the practice in Ipswich, Suffolk, England, of Brightwen Binyon (1846-1905) following his retirement.

In 1919 Arthur Welburn Field (1883-1964) joined the practice. Following Burgess's death in 1944 Field continued the practice for a few more years.
