Field, Simmons & Farey c. 1911 - c. 1912

Horace Field, Simmons & Farey [also known as Field, Simmons & Farey] was an architectural partnership formed in c.1911 when <u>Cyril Arthur Farey</u> (1888-1954) became a partner in the existing firm of <u>Horace Field & Simmons</u> established by <u>Horace Field</u> (1861?-1948) and <u>Charles Evelyn Simmons</u> (1879-1952) in c.1905. The address of the practice was given as 21 Berners Street, London in 1911. The partnership may have been short-lived as Farey appears to have been working independently in 1913.
