

Lanchester, Lucas & Lodge c. 1923 - 1939

Lanchester, Lucas & Lodge originated as [Lucas & Lodge](#), an architectural partnership formed by [Thomas Geoffry Lucas](#) (1872-1947), and [Thomas Arthur Lodge](#) (1888-1967) in London, England in c.1913. The title of the firm changed to Lanchester, Lucas & Lodge in 1923 [or 1920 - sources differ] when [Henry Vaughan Lanchester](#) (1863-1953) joined the practice. Lucas withdrew from the partnership in 1930 and thereafter practised independently. The title of the firm subsequently changed to [Lanchester & Lodge](#)
