Knott & Mosely

Knott & Mosely was an architectural partnership formed in London, England by Arthur Stocken Knott (1898-1980) and his wife, Edna Mosely (1899-1954) [also known as Mrs Arthur Stocken Knott]. The practise was active until at least 1939.
