

Rowntree & Son 1912 - 1919

Fred Rowntree & Son was an architectural partnership formed by [Frederick \(Fred\) Rowntree](#) (1860-1927) and his son [Douglas Woodville Rowntree](#) (1888-1966) in Hammersmith, London in 1912.

The practice was renamed [Fred Rowntree & Sons](#) in 1919 when another son, [Colin Rowntree](#) (1891-1965), joined the firm.
