## **Rowntree & Son 1912 - 1919**

Fred Rowntree & Son was an architectural partnership formed by <u>Frederick (Fred)</u> <u>Rowntree</u> (1860-1927) and his son <u>Douglas Woodville Rowntree</u> (1888-1966) in Hammersmith, London in 1912.

The practice was renamed <u>Fred Rowntree & Sons</u> in 1919 when another son, <u>Colin</u> <u>Rowntree</u> (1891-1965), joined the firm.
