

Douglas & Fordham 1884 - 1898

Douglas & Fordham was an architectural partnership formed in Chester, Cheshire, England in January 1884 by [John Douglas](#) (1830-1911) and [Daniel Porter Fordham](#) (1845?-?). The partnership was dissolved in 1898.

Projects by Douglas & Fordham included Abbeystead House in Abbeystead, Lancashire (1885-87); Church of St James the Great in Haydock, Cheshire (c.1891-92); St Wenefrede's Church in Bickley, Cheshire (1892); All Saints Church in Higher Kinnerton, Flintshire (1893); Brocksford Hall in Doveridge, Derbyshire (1893); 38 Bridge Street in Chester, Cheshire (Fordham, 1897); Congregational Church in Great Crosby, Lancashire (1897-98)
