## Haslam, Robert Heywood 1878 - 1954

Robert Heywood Haslam was born in Bolton, Lancashire, England on 8 March 1878 and was articled to <u>C.F.A. Voysey</u> (1857-1941). He subsequently worked as an architect in Wonersh, Surrey.

Haslam appears to have been in partnership with <u>Alfred Wickham Jarvis</u> (1865-1945) in c.1900. Drawings by A. Wickham Jarvis of the exterior and interior of a house at Branksome for R.E. Haslam designed by A. Wickham and Haslam are illustrated in 'Modern British Architecture and Decoration' edited by Charles Holme (London: The Studio, 1901 pp.106, 107, 109)

In 1924 Haslam became a member of the Art Workers Guild. He died in in Wonersh on 9 April 1954
