

Bunney & Makins 1905 - ?

Bunney & Makins [also known as Michael Bunney & Clifford Makins] was an architectural partnership formed in London, England in 1905 by Michael Frank Wharlton Bunney (1873-1927) and Clifford Copeman Makins (1876-1963). The practice was active until at least the mid-1920s.

Wales, 1912; town planning work at Gidea Park, Prestatyn, Southampton, Doncaster and elsewhere; factory at Hove, 1914.
