Grayson & Ould was an architectural partnership formed by <u>George Enoch</u> <u>Grayson</u> (1833-1912) and <u>Edward Augustus Lyle Ould</u> (1852-1909) in Liverpool, Lancashire England in 1886. <u>George Hastwell Grayson</u> (1871–1951), grandson of George Enoch Grayson became a partner in the firm in 1897.
