

Dunn & Curtis Green 1916 - 1919

Dunn & Curtis Green originated as [Dunn & Watson](#), an architectural practice established in London, England in 1890 by [William Newton Dunn](#) (1859-1934) and [Robert Watson](#) (1865-1916). In 1912 William Curtis Green (1875-1960) joined the practice which was renamed [Dunn, Watson & Curtis Green](#). Following the death of Watson in 1916 the firm became [Dunn & Curtis Green](#). The partnership was dissolved in 1919 when Dunn retired to Kenya
