

Holford, George 1851 - c. 1938

George Holford was born in Brighton, Sussex, England in 1851 and was articled to Thomas Simpson (1825–1908) a local architect. In 1876, with [Charles Edward Clayton](#) (1851-1938) who had also trained with Simpson, he formed the architectural partnership [Holford & Clayton](#) in Brighton. In 1882 [Ernest Black](#) (1855-1917) joined the practice which was renamed [Holford, Clayton & Black](#). Holford left the following year, at which point the firm became [Clayton & Black](#).

Nothing is known about Holford's later career as an architect. He is thought to have died in 1938 but this has not been confirmed.
