Holford, George 1851 - c. 1938

George Holford was born in Brighton, Sussex, England in 1851 and was articled to Thomas Simpson (1825–1908) a local architect. In 1876, with <u>Charles Edward</u> <u>Clayton</u> (1851-1938) who had also trained with Simpson, he formed the architectural partnership <u>Holford & Clayton</u> in Brighton. In 1882 <u>Ernest Black</u> (1855-1917) joined the practice which was renamed <u>Holford, Clayton & Black</u>. Holford left the following year, at which point the firm became <u>Clayton & Black</u>.

Nothing is known about Holford's later career as an architect. He is thought to have died in 1938 but this has not been confirmed.
