

Holford, Clayton & Black 1882 - 1883

Holford, Clayton & Black had its origin in [Holford & Clayton](#), an architectural partnership formed in Brighton, Sussex, England in 1876 by [George Holford](#) (1851-1938?) and [Charles Edward Clayton](#) (1851-1938). In 1882 [Ernest Black](#) (1855-1917) joined the practice which was renamed Holford, Clayton & Black. Holford left the following year, at which point the firm became [Clayton & Black](#).
