## Holford, Clayton & Black 1882 - 1883

Holford, Clayton & Black had its origin in <a href="Holford & Clayton">Holford & Clayton</a>, an architectural partnership formed in Brighton, Sussex, England in 1876 by by <a href="George Holford">George Holford</a> (1851-1938?) and <a href="Charles Edward Clayton">Charles Edward Clayton</a> (1851-1938). In 1882 <a href="Ernest Black">Ernest Black</a> (1855-1917) joined the practice which was renamed Holford, Clayton & Black. Holford left the following year, at which point the firm became <a href="Clayton & Black">Clayton & Black</a>.
