

Knapp-Fisher, Powell & Russell 1919 - ?

Knapp-Fisher, Powell & Russell was an architectural partnership formed by [Arthur Bedford Knapp-Fisher](#) (1888-1965), [Andrew Laurence Noel Russell](#) (1887-1969) and [Lawrence Powell](#) (1888-1973) in London, England in 1919. The firm was active until at least the early 1950s.
