

## **Burnet, Sir John Tait & Lorne 1930 - c. 1948**

Sir John Burnet Tait & Lorne was an architectural partnership formed in London, England in 1930 by [Sir John James Burnet](#) (1857-1938), [Thomas Smith Tait](#) (1882-1954), and Francis Lorne (1889-1963). The partnership was dissolved in c.1948.
