## Campbell-Jones, Sons & Smithers c. 1920 - ?

Campbell-Jones, Sons originated as Campbell-Jones & Sons, an architectural partnership formed in London, England in 1919 by William Campbell-Jones (1862-1951) and his sons. Soon after, <u>Alec Smithers</u> (1878-1949) joined the practice which was renamed Campbell-Jones, Sons & Smithers. The firm was acive until at least the late 1930s

A bank with offices above at 1 King William Street, London (1921-22); Bouverie House, Fleet Street, London (1926); and the People's Palace cinema at 319 Mile End Road, London (1936).
