Morley Horder & Poulter was an architectural partnership forned in London, England in 1919 by <u>Percy Richard Morley Horder</u> (1870-1944) and <u>Briant Alfred</u> <u>Poulter</u> (1881-1972). The partnership was dissolved in 1925

Worked in UK Works

Architectural projects by the practice included the National Institute of Agricultural Botany in Cambridge, Cambridgeshire (1919-21); buildings for University College, Nottingham, now the University of Nottingham (1922-28); and a number of shops for Boots the Chemists
