

Cole-Adams, Walter Alwyn 1891 - 1971

Walter Alwyn Cole-Adams was born in Lambeth, London on 23 October 1891. It is not known where he trained as an architect. During the 1930s he was in partnership with [William George Lloyd Cheriton](#) (1888-1975) and [Arthur Todd Phillips](#) (1887-1957) as Cole-Adam, Phillips & Cheriton, and, when Cheriton left the practice, as [Cole-Adam & Phillips](#). Cole-Adams & Philips had an office at 45 Lower Belgrave Street, London.

Cole-Adams was elected an Associate of the Royal Institute of British Architects (ARIBA) in 1921 and a Fellow of the Royal Institute of British Architects (FRIBA) in 1937. He died in Plymouth, Devon in 1971
