## Milnes, Eli 1830 - 1899

Eli Milnes was born in Bradford, Yorkshire, England in 1830 and was articled to Walter Rawsorne (?-1867). He subsequently practised as an architect in Bradford. He was in partnership with Jonathan Dixon (1802-1854) and, from 1863, with <u>Charles France</u> as <u>Milnes & France</u>. In 1888 Milnes's son, <u>Charles Edward Milnes</u> (1862-?) and France's son, <u>Arthur Alderson France</u> (1863-1916) became partners in the firm.

Eli Milnes died in Knaresborough, Yorkshire West Riding on 8 December 1899
