

Davidson & Murphy c. 1907 - ?

Davidson & Murphy [also known as W. Davidson & Bailey S. Murphy] appears to have been a short-lived partnership formed in Edinburgh, Scotland in c.1907 between William Davidson (1875-1934) and [Bailey Scott Murphy](#) (1876-1914). In 1907 they submitted an entry for a competition to design buildings for the Scottish National Exhibition held in Edinburgh in 1908. Their designs are illustrated in *British Competitions in Architecture* vol. 2, no. 14, December 1907 (pp. 60-63).

It is possible that Davidson & Murphy was not a formal partnership but was formed specifically for this project and that they didn't design anything else.
