

Shewbrooks & Hodges 1903 - 1910

Shewbrooks & Hodges was an architectural partnership formed by [Edward Shewbrooks](#) (1842-1910) and [Henry Todd Hodges](#) (1878-1958) in Newcastle upon Tyne, England in 1903. In 1908 they submitted an entry for a competition to design municipal buildings in Bethnal Green, London. Their designs are illustrated in *British Competitions in Architecture* vol. 2, no. 15, February 1908 (pp. 98, 110, 111). The partnership was dissolved in 1910 following the death of Shewbrooks. Hodges emigrated to Australia two years later.
