

Withers & Meredith c. 1907 - 1916

Withers & Meredith was an architectural partnership formed in London, England in c.1907 by [George Edward Withers](#) (1873-1945) and [Percy William Meredith](#) (1874-1938). In 1908 they submitted an entry for a competition to design municipal buildings in Bethnal Green, London. Their designs are illustrated in *British Competitions in Architecture* vol. 2, no. 15, February 1908 (pp. 102-103). The partnership was dissolved in 1916.
