Bulman* in c.1907 In 1908 they submitted an entry for a competition to design municipal buildings in Bethnal Green, London. Their designs are illustrated in British Competitions in Architecture vol. 2, no. 15, February 1908 (pp. 106-107).

The address of the firm was given as 67/69 Chancery Lane, London in 1908, and Queen Victoria Street, London in 1910
