

Appleyard & Quiggin

Appleyard & Quiggin was an architectural partnership formed by [Henry Milnthorpe Appleyard](#) (1873-1941) and [Edgar Quiggin](#) (1880-1950). They had an office at 67 Lord Street, Liverpool. In 1909 Appleyard & Quiggin was selected 3rd place in a competition to design the Municipal Secondary School for Boys and Girls in Bury, Lancashire. Their entry is illustrated in *British Competitions in Architecture* vol. 2, no. 23, July 1909 (pp. 355-357).
