

Poulton, Denis 1901 - 1981

Denis Poulton was born Reading, Berkshire, England on 16 July 1901 and studied at Liverpool University School of Architecture. From 1931 to c.1938 he was in partnership with [William Stanley Grice](#) (1889-1952) as Grice & Poulton [W. S. Grice & Denis Poulton]. He also worked at one time with Sir Herbert Baker.

Poulton was elected an Associate of the Royal Institute of British Architects (ARIBA) in 1929. His address was given as 2 Wellington Square, Oxford in 1930; 21 Porchester Square, London in 1931 and 1935; 21 Upper Berkeley Street, Portman Square, London in 1932 and 1933; 50 Baker Street, London in 1935 and 1938; 25 Devonshire Close, London in 1939; and Chestnut Cottage, Maidensgrove, Oxfordshire 1981. He died in Henley, Oxfordshire, England in 1981
