

Granger & Leathart c. 1925 - 1935

Granger & Leathart [also known as W F Granger & Julian Rudolph Leathart, and as W. F. Granger & J. R. Leathart] was an architectural partnership formed in London, England in the mid-1920s by [Julian Rudolph Leathart](#)(1891-1967) and [William Fraser Granger](#) (1888-1969). The practice designed numerous cinemas. The partnership was dissolved in 1935
