Granger & Leathart [also known as W F Granger & Julian Rudolph Leathart, and as W. F. Granger & J. R. Leathart] was an architectural partnership formed in London, England in the mid-1920s by Julian Rudolph Leathart(1891-1967) and <u>William</u> <u>Fraser Granger</u> (1888-1969). The practice designed numerous cinemas. The partnership was dissolved in 1935
