

Baker, Harold 1890 - ?

Harold Baker was born on 14 June 1890. It is not known where or with whom he trained as an architect. Between 1917 and 1928 he was in partnership with [Thomas Falconer](#) (1879-1934), first in Amberley, Gloucestershire and later in London. From 1922, when [John A. Campbell](#) (1878-1948) joined the practice, the firm was known as [Falconer, Baker & Campbell](#).

Baker was elected a Licentiate of the Royal Institute of British Architects (LRIBA) in 1931. He was active as an architect in London until at least 1939.
