Other projects by the firm included Christ Church, Norris Green, Liverpool (1930-32); St. Michael's cgurch, Sefton (1931); St. Mary the Virgin church, Liverpool (1953); St. Anne's church, Wigan (1953); a new operating theatre suite for the children's hospital at Alder Hey, Liverpool (c.1955); St. Oswald church (1961); a burns and plastic surgery unit at Whiston Hospital in Whiston, Lancashire (1961-62); the Equity \& Law Building in Castle Street, Liverpool (1971); a factory for Messrs E.T. Gee \& Sons Ltd.; a shop for Messrs Ray \& Mills; offices for the Legal \& General Assurance Society, and the Liverpool Gas Co.; the Junior School in Morton, Wallasey; a sales room for Messrs Lyons \& Co.; and a number of private residences
