Morris De Metz was born in London, England on 10 September 1907. He trained as an architect in the 1920s and was elected an Associate of the Royal Institute of British Architects (ARIBA) in 1929 and a Fellow of the Royal Institute of British Architects (FRIBA) in 1939

His address was given as 34 Upper Berkeley Street, London in 1930; 13 Devonshire Terrace, London in 1935; and 155 Oxford Street, London and 6 Vivian Way, Hampstead Garden Suburb, London in 1939. He died in London in 1990
