

T. Arnold Ashworth & Sons c. 1920 - ?

T. Arnold Ashworth & Sons [also known as T. Arnold Ashworth & Son] was an architectural partnership formed in Liverpool, England in c.1920 by [Thomas Arnold Ashworth](#) (c.1855-?) and his two sons, [Bertram Ashworth](#) (1882-1966) and Ronald Comer Ashworth (1885-1950). Their office was located at 14 Castle Street, Liverpool. By the 1930s the title of the firm had changed to T. Ashworth & Son. The practice was active until at least the early 1950s
