Rowland Plumbe & Partners was an architectural partnership formed in London, England in 1913 by <u>Rowland Plumbe</u> (1838-1919), <u>John Lionel Fleming-Williams</u> (1879-1919) and <u>John Charles Stephen Mummery</u> (1862-1949). The practice was continued by Mummery following the death of Plumbe and Fleming-Williams in 1919, and eventually closed in 1933.
